Note, both the Hampton and Springhill/TownPlace Suites offer continental breakfast included with lodging. The FourPoints does not, however they do have a restaurant.



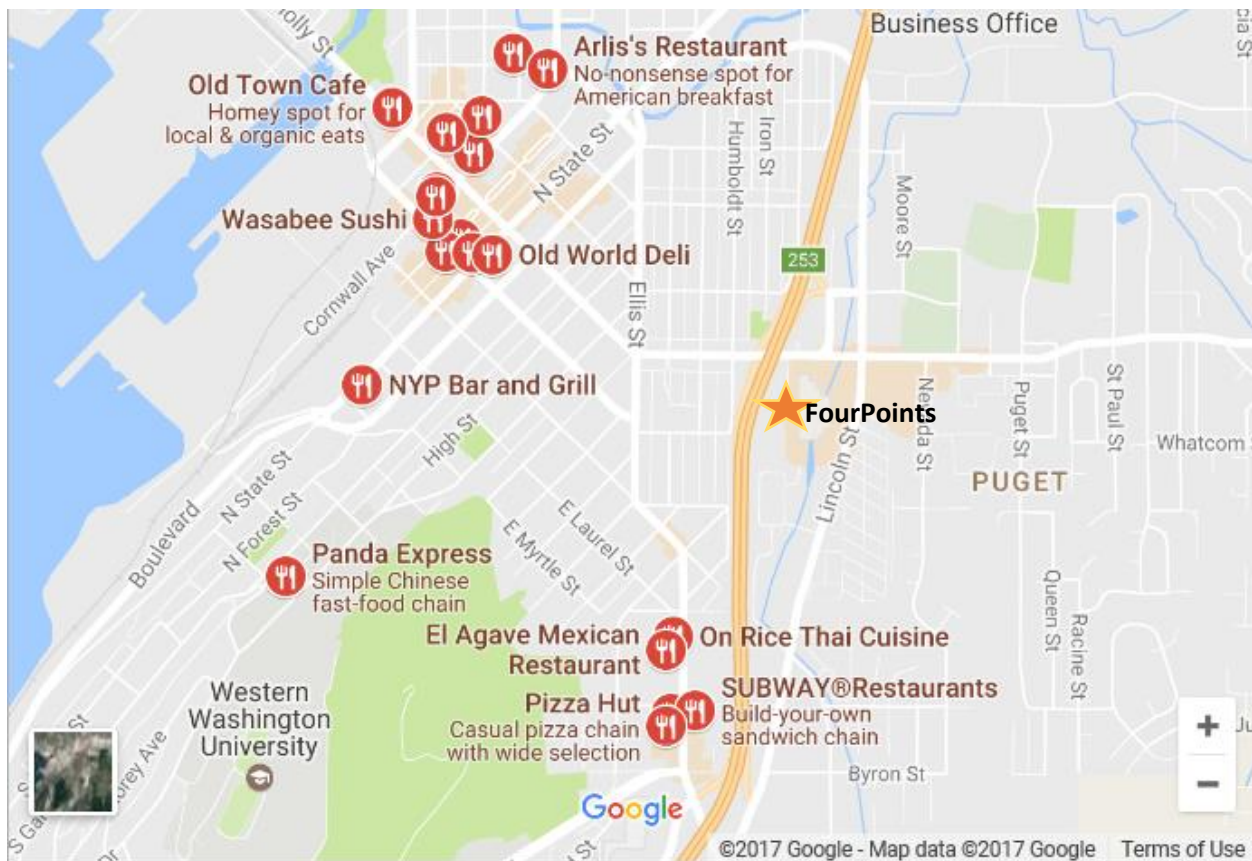
