Discover Our Collection

Books

Total physical books: 10,000+

You will find all of our books on the upper floor of the library, arranged according to the Library of Congress classification system.

eBooks and Research Databases

Total eBooks: 175,000+

Visit our website to discover and gain access to our 175k+ eBook as well as multiple research databases. Video content is also available in some databases.

Course Reserves

Located behind the information desk on the main floor, these books can only be checked out for two hours at a time, for in-library use only.

Zines

Located on the main floor of the library near the windows, our zine collection covers diverse topics and stories.

Periodicals

Physical magazines and journals are available on the library's upper floor. The student creative magazine, *The Lion's Pride*, is also available behind the front desk.

Computers

Desktop computers with Internet access and various software are available to all. Visit the information desk if you require assistance logging in.

Reference Resources

Located on the library's upper floor, the reference collection includes encyclopedias, dictionaries, and other comprehensive resources. These materials cannot be checked out of the library.

Movies and Audio CDs

Total DVD and Blu-ray movies: 2,500+

Movies and audio CDs are on the main floor of the library, arranged by date of acquisition. Movies come in two formats: DVD and Blu-ray, and include popular, independent, and instructional subject matter.

Cameras, Laptops, & Other Technology

We check out many different types of technology at the information desk. Student laptops are for in-library use only. A detailed list of all our technology is on the website.

Indigenous Peoples Collection (IPC)

The IPC focuses on native culture and history within the region and beyond. Look for the green "IPC" label on the spine of books and movies in our general collection.

Oversized and Easy Reading Books

Located on the upper floor of the library, adjacent to the General Collection. Easy Reading books are organized by level.

WiFi Access

LLC spaces have high-speed WiFi access for all. Individuals with an SID can connect to "LWTech" and visitors can connect to "LWTech-Visitors."

Printers, Copiers, and Scanners

Print machines are available on both floors. Students/staff may access printer functions with an SID. General public will need to request access.

Computer Lab (Quiet Zone)

Located on the main floor of the library, this space provides specialized software for academic programs and is a designated quiet zone.

Study Rooms

There are three study rooms in the library that may be reserved at the information desk or through the library website. These rooms support individual and group needs.
