Data for collections pulled from Alma, is based on collection in April 2018. We do not have access to the data as it stood last year as we switched to a new library system. Books are decreased due to weeding project last year. Media has been updated to include following Alma categories: Visual Materials (DVDs), Music, Mixed Material, and Computer Files. For Serials (Journals in Alma), we have cut several titles in the last year, and included in this survey are issues we still have in our collection even if subscriptions have been canceled. eBooks: this is pulled from a Primo search for eBooks and includes openly licensed eBooks we promote, which explains the significant increase. Proprietary and open access databases present on our website and in Primo are included in the number of databases. e-media: this data will not be entirely accurate, and is based on a search in Primo for AVV, Maps, Other, Images, with "Full Text Online" selected. e-circ: no access to this data, thus leaving 0.
