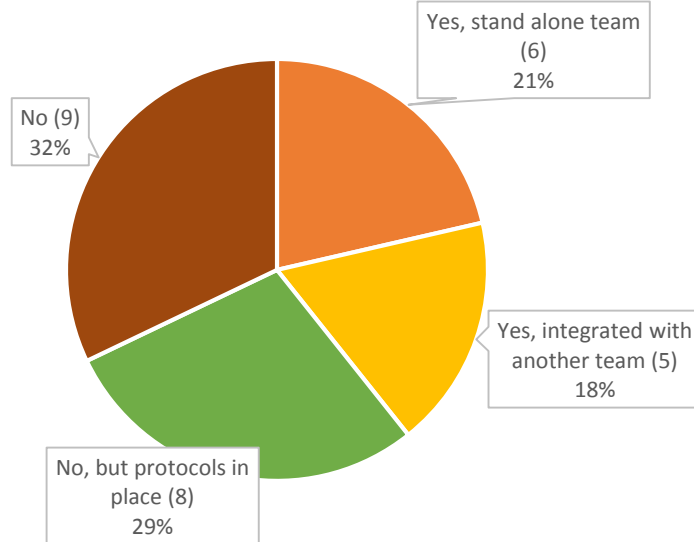


WSSSC Bias Response Team Questionnaire

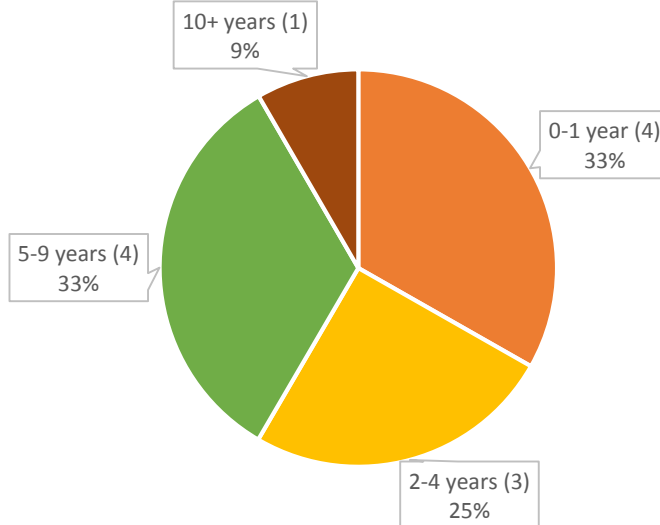
Does your campus have a designated Bias Response Team?

■ Yes, stand alone team (6) ■ Yes, integrated with another team (5) ■ No, but protocols in place (8) ■ No (9)

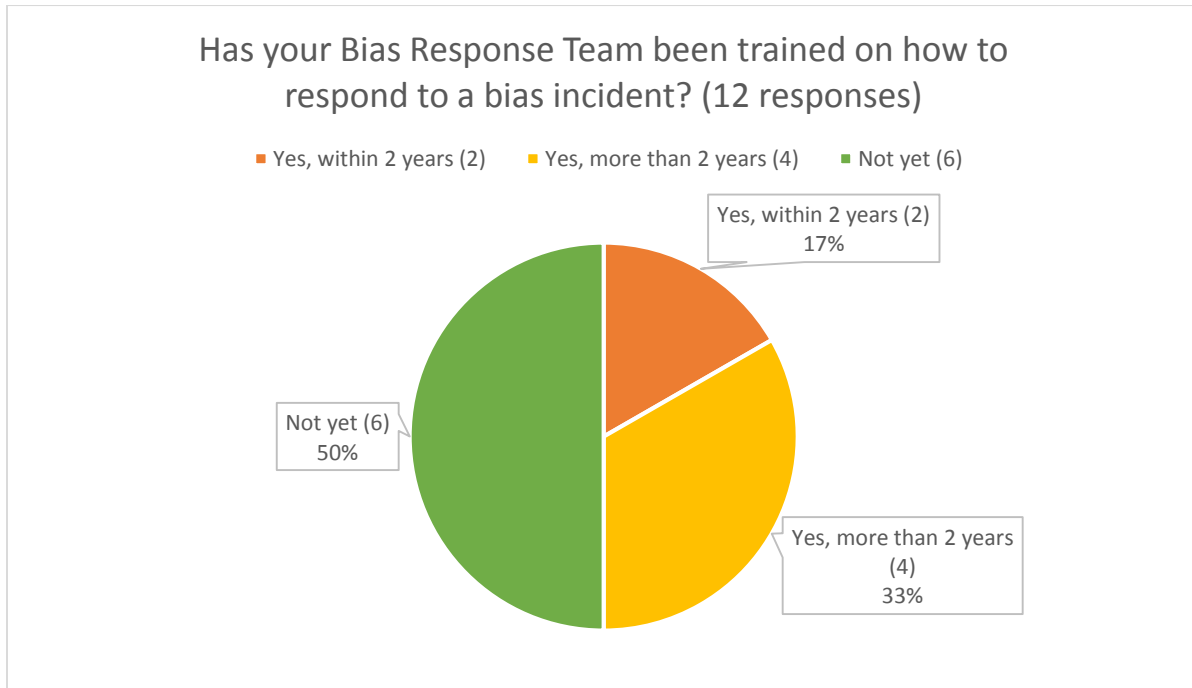


How long has your Bias Response Team been in operation?
