Well, the company partnering with the State Board for Community Colleges has filed for Chapter 11 protection under the bankruptcy laws. And, on Friday, April 24, that company CIBER filed a lawsuit against the State and State Board for Community and Technical Colleges. Over 100 million dollars of student money has already been spent on this new system plus more millions will be spent. And, a system you probably will never use. All the colleges have been already sending in maintenance fees totaling millions of dollars per year and most colleges are not even using it yet.
