- Apply for financial aid** (FAFSA or WASFA) online at fafsa.ed.gov or readyssetgrad.org/wasfa. For more information visit the Financial Aid Office in Wenatchi Hall (509.682.6810).
- Determine if you need to take the placement test.** Take the Pre-Placement Questionnaire at www.wvc.edu/placement.
- Sign up for advising & registration.** Learn about degree requirements, registering for classes, and more. Contact the Educational Planning & Testing Center (509.682.6830).
- Schedule an appointment with the Career Center** if you are undecided about what you want to study (509.682.6830).
- Register for classes and print out your schedule.**
- Pay tuition** at least **two weeks before classes start** to secure your seat in classes. Pay at the Cashier Office in Wenatchi Hall.
- Buy textbooks.** Books are available one week before classes start at the College Bookstore in Van Tassell.
- Attend classes and meet with your faculty advisor.**
- Become involved.** Visit Van Tassell to learn about student organizations, ASWVC, Campus Life, Equity & Inclusion, Student Rec Center and Student Housing.
