

Additional guidance to complement the [2022-2023 Running Start ESSER Grant Guidelines](#)

As summarized in the Program Overview of the program and fiscal guidelines, allowable expenses include:

- Tuition and fee costs to cover summer quarter credits in the areas of college success preparatory courses and credit recovery courses that meet needed high school graduation requirements, either through course completion or in alignment with a district's mastery-based learning policy.
- Tuition and fee cost to cover expenses over the 1.2 FTE limitation and/or over 15 quarter credits, for students pursuing professional technical programs for fall, winter, spring, and summer (all courses for summer).
- Outreach and recruitment materials to communicate this funding opportunity to students, families, communities, and schools.
- Programming costs to run courses that are deemed necessary to ensure students have the courses they need to support high school graduation and degree requirements.
- Funding to cover program related costs to students (i.e., materials to participate in prof tech lab work).

*Credit Recovery**

- Any rising junior or senior that is deficient in credits for a high school diploma may enroll in summer courses.
 - Students that withdraw, fail, or never complete a requirement for a high school diploma, as determined by their high school counselor (form is being developed for counselors to indicate what credits their students are deficient in).
- If students are pursuing a high school diploma through their ctc (via completion of an AA) then they can take a summer course towards their AA **IF** they are deficient as determined by their ctc advisor.
 - i. Examples can include:
 1. A student fails a course during fall, winter, and spring that puts them behind from obtaining their AA and high school diploma on time.

*College Success Course**

- Any rising junior or senior that enrolls in **ANY** college success course.

*Professional Technical Programs**

- Any rising junior or senior that enrolls in a professional technical program or course.
- Any recently graduated senior completing a certificate or degree for a professional technical program in summer (students must be on track to complete by end of summer quarter).

**All courses funded through ESSER must be 100 level and above*

Out of pocket expenses
