OVERVIEW

CSF supports a differentiated college-services model, including:

One-on-one supports through trained coaches who help improve student performance and goal achievement through self-directed learning and development. Note: coaching begins summer before freshman year and ends upon graduation.

Scholarships and Emergency Funds that help remove financial barriers to persistence and completion.

Timely access to support and content through CSF's studentfacing website, text-messages, e-mail or phone.

Webinars and workshops designed to develop student's academic and non-academic skills, as well as their connections to peers and professionals.



COACHING APPROACH




Fig. 1: Seven Life Domains

Coaches training in Fostering Success coaching model that assess student performance in Seven Life Domains (see. Fig 1), partners to prioritize goals and teaches by providing the knowledge, skill-building and/or resources required to achieve identified goals.

Other highlights

CSF has awarded over **\$19M** in scholarships to students attending institutions with 2-year programs

In the past 3 years, awarded nearly **\$80K** in Emergency Funds to students attending institutions with 2-year programs

CSF scholars enrollment in institutions offering 2-year programs has increased by **35%** in the past 5 years

Key Results

- **61%** direct-to-college enrollment rate for FY 22 cohort
- **87% vs. 84%** (CSF coaching participants vs. national) persistence for students enrolled at 4-year institutions
- 65% vs. 62% (CSF coaching participants vs. national) for students enrolled in 2-year institutions
- 14% vs 44% (CSF coaching participants vs. National) stop-out rates during first two years of college
- 92% of CSF coaching participants share their coach plays some role in helping them succeed in college.
