Primary Focus Areas & Hot Topics

Bulleted list or brief description of top focus areas and scope of impact

There are currently 35 major projects in the pipeline. The average cost of these projects in 2022 dollars is \$35.7 million. Current estimates are that it will take at least 6 biennia to fully fund all the major projects in the queue if our system receives at least \$500 million each biennium.

There is a need for a mid-range project process, aiming at needs with estimated costs between \$2 million and under \$10 million. **The rationale for this range** is that minor capital projects are capped at \$2 million and must be expended in one biennium, while any capital project above \$10 million must submit a pre-design document for OFM approval which would be an added cost.
