#### **Primary Focus Areas & Hot Topics**

There are currently 35 major projects in the pipeline. The average cost of these projects in 2022 dollars is \$35.7 million. Current estimates are that it will take at least six biennia to fully fund all the major projects in the queue if our system receives at least \$500 million each biennium.

The committee is exploring the potential of mid-range projects costing between \$2 - \$10 million. The rationale for this range is that minor capital projects are <u>capped at \$2 million</u> and must be expended in one biennium, while any capital project <u>above \$10 million</u> must submit a predesign document for OFM approval which would be an added cost.
