

Apprenticeship Fee Guidance for the 2025-27 Biennium

Tuition

The State Board for Community and Technical Colleges (SBCTC) issues policy on tuition and fee rates annually, and these can be accessed on the <u>SBCTC's website under "Tuition and Fees"</u>.

For <u>apprenticeship courses</u>, apprenticeship students are eligible for a fifty percent waiver on the standard tuition (operating and building fees) and services and activities (S&A) fees.

Contract Rates for the 2025-27 Biennium

SBCTC has established a maximum value for use by colleges contracting with apprenticeship training sponsors for instruction. This rate provides a consistent value for the community and technical college system, but it is provided as a courtesy and is not binding.

The maximum value for the 2025-27 biennium (July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2027) is \$3,993. This rate already includes any potential negotiated rent. The value is established on a biennial basis, utilizing the state operating allocations from the prior biennium.
