Primary Focus Areas & Hot Topics

Bulleted list or brief description of top focus areas and scope of impact

The WACTC Capital Committee continues to meet monthly. Meetings are chaired by Dr. Darrell Cain, president of Pierce College-Puyallup and supported by Wayne Doty, SBCTC Capital Budget Director.

At the February 25 meeting, the committee discussed the Business Affairs Commission (BAC) task force's recommendations. First reviewed was recommendations regarding replacing buildings that are not old or in bad shape. Typically, these buildings have outlived their usefulness. Second, the committee reviewed the task force's recommendations for revising major scoring criteria recommendations to address potential systemic racial bias in these criteria. These discussions continued during the March 25 meeting.

In addition, on March 25, representatives from Spokane Community College presented background, analysis and a request to move the planned Apprenticeship Center to the main campus, moving the project in the pipeline to after Centralia College and before Skagit Valley College.

During the April 29 meeting, the committee reviewed the attached WACTC proposal to be presented at their April 30 meeting for a first reading. The WACTC vote is projected to occur on June 4, 2021.
